### **OUTLOOK/LOOKOUT: OPEN DOOR CHURCH GOES TO THE PHILIPPINES!**

Today we welcome Andy & Army Hudson to tell us about it:

Rolando de Guzman is a Pastor in Cavite in the Philippines and is the brother of Army Hudson who is a member of Open Door Church Sunbury. He came to England to visit for three months in 2016 and had many chats with our Pastor, Andy Phillips. He shared with Andy how they reach out to street children and how they visit two prisons weekly getting up at 2am in the morning to cook food for the inmates.

Rolando wanted to extend his work reaching out to the street children and also wanted to begin a ministry for the elderly. It was agreed that a group from Open Door Church would come out to the Philippines in November 2017 and help them to run a Kidz Klub for 300 street children! We will also help them begin a work with the elderly, and leadership training will be given too. We will join them going into the prisons and in door to door knocking inviting people to an evangelistic night.
