 What was the key difference between her and Orpah?
- Can you remember a time when a decision was logically wrong but in Christ you knew it to be right? Explain.
- What key Christlike characteristics does Ruth display in this chapter?
 How did Christ demonstrate these characteristics towards us?
- Which of Ruth's attributes would you like to have in greater quantity? Explain your reasons.
