## Read Acts 14 v 8-20

- 1. Discuss this account of a day in the life of St. Paul and try to imagine what he may have thought.
- 2. Think and tell your group of an occasion in your own life or a story that you have heard where the outcome was just not fair.
- 3. Jesus says, "In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world." John16:33
  - How does this scripture make you feel?
  - Can you think of a time when you had to talk to yourself or let others talk you into TAKING HEART! How did that work out?
- 4. St James writes "Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds" (1:2)
  - How can we help ourselves and each other to do this?
- 5. Why do you think we are often surprised, maybe angry or disillusioned when there is an 'It's not fair' situation?
  - Discuss: should we expect things to work out well or to give us grief?
  - Think of someone who is going through difficulties right now and ask God to show you how you could help.
- 6. The passage also includes a miracle. What are you doing about miracles?
- 7. Is there anything that you can do, with others maybe, to make this world a bit fairer?
- 8. "There is a day that all creation's waiting for" is a line of a song. Where can we find this in scripture? Should we be celebrating this day? (Rev. 21:1-4)
