The truth of the matter was that even though he had been in the same household his entire life, he did not genuinely understand how his father truly felt about him. What an amazing tragedy.

This tragedy can persist in the church today. As a consequence it is totally vital that we know how our heavenly Father genuinely feels towards us and as a result where we find our identity in Him.

Richard Jones from Fatherheart Ministries joins us this morning in order to introduce the Father Heart programme that he and his wife Nia will be running over four weeks for our church (see inside). It's a great opportunity to genuinely know the truth of divine Fatherhood and allow that truth to set us free from the shackles of slavery, abandonment or some other misconception that we've inadvertently acquired.
