EASTER AT JUBILEE

Good Friday - 19 April, 10am Mike will lead us for a short, reflective service as we consider the story of Jesus' trial and crucifixion, and what it means to us.

Jesus stepping out of the tomb at the dawn of Easter Sunday is by far the most important event in the whole of human and indeed cosmic history. His resurrection is the first spark of eternal life and permanence to a dark world overcome by death and decay. It is a cause for huge rejoicing and celebration because it marks a victory that is not limited and temporary but all-encompassing and permanent.
