SERBIA VISIT

As many of you know, Jon Priddy and I recently visited Serbia, Croatia and Bosnia (thank you for your prayers for us). We were there at the invitation of Miroslav Fic (Miro) who oversees the Commission churches in the Balkans region. He and his wife Snežana were excellent hosts; Miro took us to visit a number of church leaders in the three countries (the total mileage he does in a year is incredible).



We also attended a number of church services and meetings in different locations where Jon shared his testimony and I had the privilege of preaching (three times on the Sunday which was quite a test of stamina).

We enjoyed our visit immensely but there is no getting away from the fact that things are very hard for the Commission network of churches in these three countries. Young people are leaving in droves to work in the EEC which has impacted the churches considerably. In addition with national identity being so strongly linked with religion in the Balkans (Serbian Orthodox in Serbia, Catholicism in Croatia and Islam in Bosnia) there is almost a sense of betrayal of country if one leaves the established religion to join an evangelical church.



We will share much more in the coming weeks but Miro and his team of pastors would greatly benefit from our love, support and prayers in the coming months and years. DWP
