BAGS OF LIGHT for Halloween

There are many thoughts on how Christians can deal with Halloween, and we would not want to argue about it! But perhaps we could think of 'trick or treating' in a different way: what if we were to welcome people to our door on this particular evening and not only hand them the sugar they have asked for but also use this opportunity to spread the good news that Jesus is the light in this dark world.



Why not pick up a few of our 'Bags of Light' which include a special tract especially made for children, invitations to our upcoming events and a card with our church details letting them know we are here for them. These will be available at church on Sundays in October.

What we would ask you to do is to pray as you put a few (wrapped) sweets in each bag which you can hand out on the night to anyone who knocks on your door; you will be sowing seeds into the lives of the young people and even their parents/carers.

This idea is just a suggestion - we certainly would not want to pressure you into something you don't feel comfortable or safe with, and would urge you to do what's right for you. Why not pray about this, and chat with others about it while deciding.

If you don't want trick or treaters to knock, it's a good idea to leave your door unlit, or perhaps leave a polite sign there - feel free to ask us for one, or there are many around from Surrey Police or Neighbourhood Watch.



If you would welcome a visit, then perhaps leave a light on or decorate your doorway - maybe carve out a pumpkin with a simple Christian design like a cross, and put a nightlight inside. Or maybe you could display a poster with a picture of one - we'll have some you could take to use. God bless you whatever you decide!
