
Donations can be dropped off at the Jubilee Centre. We have a box in the porch where donations can be placed if no one is there. Please contact us if you need to arrange a large drop off.

Thank you to everyone who donated to the Poppy Appeal via the box in the Jubilee Centre this year. We collected £67.25 for The Royal British Legion.


