- After the reading I always like to consider asking 'what immediately stands out in the passage?'

Introduction

Have you ever crossed a river or lake to get to the other side? Where did you cross and was there a particular reason why you had to?

Malcolm summarised his talk with 4 key points:

- Clean up
- Listen up
- Look up
- Step up

Read Joshua 3:1-17

- 1) What are you most excited about for this new season?
- 2) In verse 4 it says 'since you've never been this way before' How could comparison have hindered the Israelites at the very start of this journey?
- 3) How could comparison hinder us today?
- 4) Why do you think the Israelites had to consecrate themselves prior to entering the Jordan?
- 5) Do you think that the promise of God in the rest of verse 5 is specifically linked?
- 6) How might we go about continually consecrating ourselves today?
- 7) How does it feel to know the 'Living God' goes ahead of us?
- 8) What examples have you experienced of God going ahead of you?
- *9)* This new generation of Israelites saw something truly miraculous have you ever seen anything physically miraculous?

10) The Israelites had to break up camp and move out – what does "setting out" on this new season mean to you?

Pray
